The only circumstance for refunds is if SHPC cancels the Mexico Mission 2018 trip. The withdrawal criteria are: the US government recommends canceling our trip, the Mexican government recommends canceling our trip, AMOR Ministries cancels our trip, our vendors recommend canceling our trip or SHPC decides to cancel the trip for any reason. If I choose to withdraw from the trip for any reason, I understand that I will receive no refund for any personal or sponsor contributions.
